Effective from 1 June 2011

Dear Users,

Please note the following points in connection with reproductions from the
Burgerbibliothek Bern:

Restrictions for conservation reasons	The Burgerbibliothek regrets that it cannot accept requests for reproductions of manuscripts and archives which, for conservation reasons, might be at risk.
Photocopies	The Burgerbibliothek does not make photocopies (Xerox copies). Users are not permitted to make their own photocopies, whether from the archives or from the collections of the manuscript and reference libraries.
Use	Reproductions and photographs of collections of the Burgerbibliothek are intended for private use exclusively. The Burgerbibliothek is to be informed in advance prior to any further use, publication or forwarding to third parties. Commercial use is subject to a separate fee.
Copyright	Users are personally responsible for observing the provisions of copyright and personality laws.
Specimen copy	The Burgerbibliothek is to be given a specimen copy, free of charge and unprompted, of any works or publications which are based on its archive collections or which make use of reproductions.
Indication of source	The use of the Burgerbibliothek's collections or reproductions is always to be accounted for in all works and publications through the correct citing of sources.
Delivery	Orders for reproductions are completed whenever possible within two weeks and sent by post (no delivery by email).
Quality	Only photo repros are suitable for professional quality (publications, commercial use).

Standing charge and surcharge

A standing charge (incl. shipping costs) of CHF 30.00 per order applies in each and every case. A surcharge of CHF 15 per 15 minutes applies for research and scanning services exceeding one hour. The following additional costs also apply:

1. Digital copies on CD (colour or black-and-white)

A4, A3 formats, max. 30 pages per reproduction CHF 10.00

Surcharges for all additional services per reproduction CHF 10.00
(large-format templates up to A2, excerpts, enlargements, max. 600 dpi, obtaining reproduction permission)

2. Paper copies (taken from existing microfilm)

Black-and-white copies (A4, A3 formats), per page CHF 2.00
Max 30 pages

3. Photographs (analogue, digital, colour, black-and-white)

Standard prints 12 x 17 cm or 18 x 24 cm Costs as per quote
Ektachrom or CD

4. Microfilms and digital copies of items of 30 pages or more

Costs as per quote

Royalty for commercial use

Newspapers, magazines, books (print and online) CHF 120.00 to CHF 800.00

Advertising purposes CHF 260.00 to CHF 800.00

TV and cinema advertising CHF 650.00 to CHF 2000.00

Taking of photographs

The taking of digital or analogue photographs of items from the Burgerbibliothek's collections is permitted subject to the following conditions:

- only by prior arrangement with the Reading Room supervisor
- only at the Reading Room table specially provided for this purpose
- no flashlight photography or tripods
- pages are to be stabilised using wedges and weighted cords exclusively
- careful handling of the archive material

Users may not photograph the following

- in general collections with legal or conservation restrictions on their use
- Documentation, specifically the portrait documentation
- Books or archives that cannot be easily opened or smoothed out
- Repros for publications (print, electronic) or commercial use
